APPELLATION: Willamette Valley AVA, Oregon, USA

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Pinot Noir

HARVEST DATA: Hand-harvested from 28 Sept - 25 Oct 2007

VINEYARD SOURCES: Multiple high-quality sites situated around the Willamette Valley including: Jacob-Hart, Momtazi, Hyland, Eagle Crest, La Colina, and others.

CELLAR TREATMENT: Aged 9-10 months in French oak barrels: complete malolactic fermentation.

DATE BOTTLED: August 2008

PRODUCTION: 13,248 cases (Also available in 375 ml half bottles)

BOTTLING CHEMISTRY: pH 3.78, TA 5.6, Alcohol 13.5%

VINTAGE NOTES:

A cold, wet spring & summer and storms during harvest made for a most challenging vintage. For those who kept up with those challenges by diligently containing the disease pressure and waiting to pick, there was little rot, some high brix levels and the reward of beautifully classic Oregon wines.

TASTING NOTES:

Perfect Pinot Noir color, burgundy red from the center to the rim and fresh aromatics of Bing cherries, ripe raspberries, plums, red currants, wet stones, tobacco, and smoke. Over time the wine deepens to reveal notes of clean earth, cloves, cinnamon and blueberries. In the mouth, the attack opens with juicy red fruit flavors and beautifully ripe acidity. Ripe tannins and a succulent texture give the REX HILL Willamette Valley Pinot Noir more definition into the long finish.

Great focus and unapologetic purity. Will reward aging.
